In an effort to host a safe and responsible event, Eye Bank Association of America and Cornea Society will implement the following safety protocols and will require attendees to abide by these policies and protocols.

- Attendees must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination status at check-in.
- Masks are required in all public spaces, including meeting rooms.

- Information about nearby rapid-testing locations will be available at the registration desk and in pre-meeting communications.
- Comfort indicators are in use to guide personal interaction among attendees.
- Sanitation supplies (masks, hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes) are freely available at registration and throughout the meeting space.
- Attendees are asked to notify meeting organizers if they develop COVID-19 symptoms, during or following the meeting, to allow for contact tracing.
- Signage throughout meeting space indicates our policies and reminds attendees to maintain social distancing.
- The hotel cleaning and sanitation policies will be shared with all attendees.
- The attendee cancellation refund policy will be relaxed this year. You may cancel your registration for a full refund if you are not feeling well prior to the event. Please note: The meeting will be recorded and will be made available on-demand to registered attendees following the event.
- Attendees must confirm that they will follow these protocols, at risk of being asked to leave the meeting, and they agree that they will not hold EBAA/Cornea Society responsible if they are exposed to, or contract, COVID-19 at our meeting.
